The Importance of a Healthy Ocean for Barnegat Light The engine cut on the Doris Mae as the passengers scrambled to the side of the boat. With patient eyes scouring the ocean, two dolphins emerged from the ocean, jumping directly into our line of sight roughly twenty yards away. We stayed out in the ocean for another half an hour, watching the dolphins interact with each other and swim around the boat.

Years later, though the Doris Mae ceased operations, taking the sunset cruise through the Barnegat Inlet remains one of my favorite activities in Barnegat Light, each time hoping to be lucky enough to be visited by the dolphins again.




Unfortunately, a major source of Barnegat Light's income and tourism appeal is at risk. According to the World Economic Forum, an independent non-profit organization, plastics found in the ocean will outweigh the amount of fish by 2050.

No one comes to Barnegat Light for the sight of a plastic water bottle being pushed by the current, or a plastic bag stuck between the rocks of the jetty. People flock to Barnegat Light for the pristine and long sandy beaches, catching fluke and sea bass, kayaking in the bay, or the occasional visit of a dolphin.

We must continue to collectively protect our oceans at all costs. It is our responsibility to maintain proper and safe ocean conditions for today and the next generation. A healthy and vibrant ocean today means preserving what we love most about Barnegat Light and Long Beach Island.

Last year the Barnegat Light Taxpayer Association hosted a guest speaker from the Save Barnegat Bay organization. The mission of Save Barnegat Bay is to restore and protect the Bay and its ecosystems through education, outreach and advocacy initiatives. We plan to work with Save Barnegat Bay this year to outline initiatives and actions we can take as an Association to support the realization of their mission.
